ARTIST BIO

Wauwatosa, Wisconsin-based, primarily self-taught, fiber artist Tanya Steele has been immersed in the arts from the beginning. She grew up in the studios as the only child of two working artists. Her earliest memories are the sound of her mother's air compressor running while she created an experimental airbrush painting, or being invited into the interior blackness of her Father's dark room while he developed photos, with only the glow of the safe light to illuminate the room. Observing her parents' work has deeply influenced who she is as a person and an artist.

Her early creative life was devoted to practicing beadwork techniques to create wearable art and jewelry. Her wearable art pieces clearly displayed her strong interest in sculptural form. As life responsibilities began to take hold, she left her creative life to pursue a corporate career as an inside sales associate.

Marrying and having a baby in 2005, she stayed home to raise her daughter. As her child grew, so did her creative life. In time, her basement studio gradually began to fill with all the art supplies that she had packed away years before. In 2019 after being introduced to needle felting, she pursued sculptural felting with zeal and curiosity. When the opportunity came to take a wet felting master class in 2020, the passion became an obsession, resulting in multiple exhibitions both national and international, a recent Award for Excellence from Fiber Art Now, and the many beautiful, complex, sculptural forms and 2-dimensional artworks we see being produced by her today.

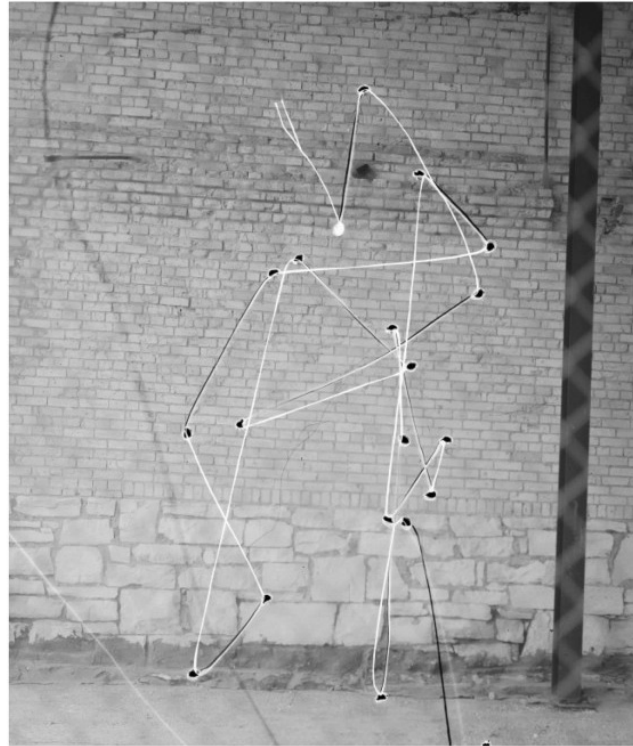
