## SOUTHEAST CHAPTER INSTALLATION PROJECTS



We have two ongoing installation projects. This means they are an OPEN CALL and applications will always be accepted. RMHC accepts 25 pieces of artwork for each hanging and Inventors Brewpub accepts 28 pieces of artwork for each hanging. Artists may enter up to three (3) pieces of art for each project. Once the maximum number of pieces have been submitted, that round will be closed and we will be accepting pieces for the next hanging. Each round of artwork hangs for three months.

We are accepting applications for the following hangings:

- **Inventors Brewpub** - Saturday, October 12 is full. We have accepted SIX (6) pieces of art, there is room for 22 more pieces of art for Round 4 which will hang on Saturday, January 12, 2025.
- **Ronald McDonald House** - Saturday, December 7, 2024, is open. We have accepted TEN (10) pieces of art and have room for FIFTEEN (15) more pieces of art.
