Southeast Chapter Calls For Art

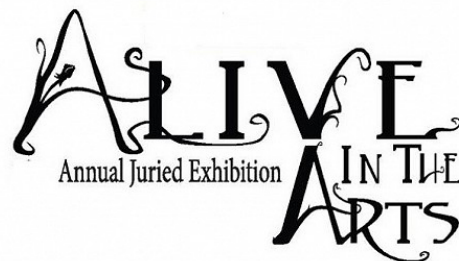
Our next exhibition will be at Inspiration Studios in West Allis, WI. The theme is **TURN UP THE HEAT**.
