In the Baker/Rowland Galleries is *Always New: The Posters of Jules Chéret*. This is the first US solo exhibition for the "father of the modern poster." Chéret was one of the first artists to bring colorful, large-scale advertisements to Paris streets, creating what critics called a "museum in the open air." It is a beautiful exhibition.
