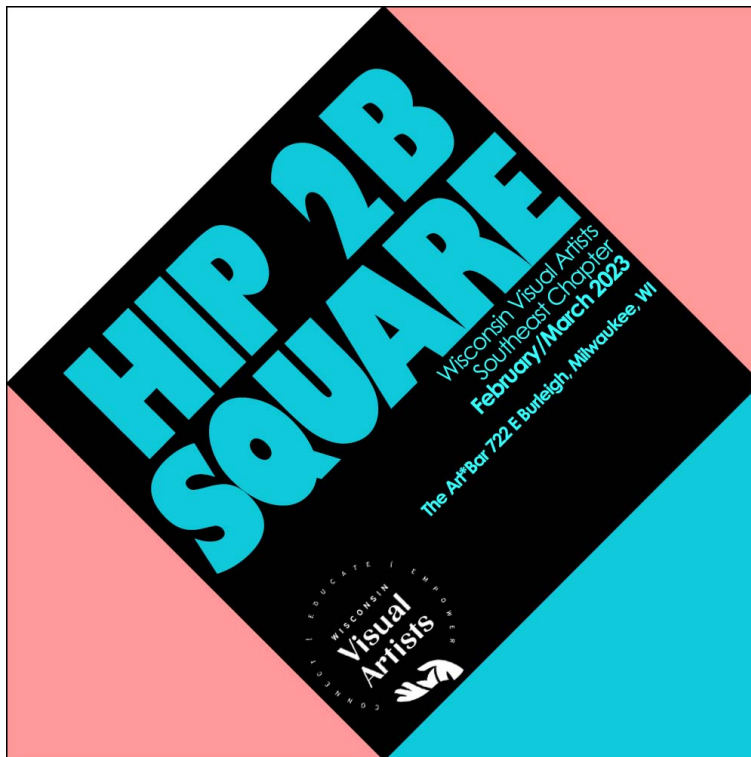

Milwaukee Art Museum

Your Milwaukee Art Museum has new hours: Wednesday, 10 am-5 pm; Thursday, 10 am-8 pm; and Friday-Sunday 10 am-5 pm.

Visit the second-floor Bradley Family Gallery to see **The Ashcan School and The Eight: "Creating a National Art."** The exhibit re-examines the artists and the social issues they depicted, drawing parallels to those still relevant today. Some praised the artists as "creating a national art" while others dismissed them as painters of rubbish or "ashcans." Ten years ago, the Milwaukee Art Museum became a leading institution for American and European self-taught art. *Playing Favorites* is a celebration of the large gift from local collector Anthony Petullo. This exhibit on the Mezzanine features drawings and paintings by self-taught artists such as Minnie Evans, Martín Ramírez, Alfred Wallis, and Adolf Wölfli

There are two photography exhibitions in the Herzfeld Center for Photography and Media Arts. They are James Benning and Sharon Lockhart: **Over Time Chapter II and On Repeat: Serial Photography.** *On Repeat: Serial Photography* draws on the Museum's collection of the 1900s and 2000s photography and examines the ways artists have used serial and sequential imagery to explore their subjects.



Franklin Boggs' **Wisconsin County Fair**

Check out new artworks on exhibit at the Museum including Franklin Boggs' Wisconsin County Fair and Edmund Lewandowski's Hockey.

The Museum Café on the Café Level, under Windhover Hall, is open. The menu features snacks, salads, and sandwiches. Indulge in art-inspired beverages by Discourse: Coffee Workshop.
